She is survived by nieces, nephews and MANY amazing friends.

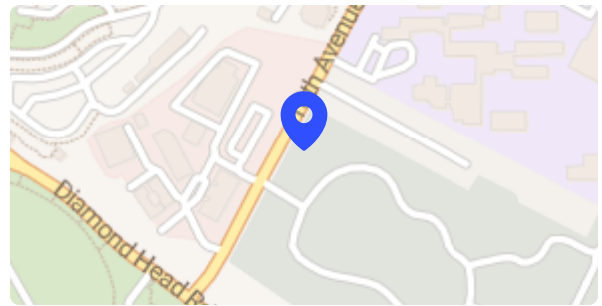

The one celebrating their birthday would get their age off their dinner bill. I was telling the neighbor what good times I had with Dee and Ernie and other square dancing friends. So sad to hear of Dee's passing. Maybe she was the one who put the egg in my head to make the martinis! We still talked several times a year, and always had a lot of things to laugh about. I will miss chatting with Dee.
